COMPANY'S POLICIES AND MANAGEMENT COMMITMENT SECURITY POLICY

Security Policy

ALPHA GAS S.A guarantees its commitment to security matters and declares that all works conducted by its personnel have sufficient supervision to comply with the provisions of the ISPS Code.

Our Policy is to provide a secure working environment by establishing and maintaining the required security measures to prevent unlawful acts that endanger the safety and security of persons and property onboard the ship. ALPHA GAS S.A objectives are to:

- Provide security procedures and practices for ships operations to protect the security of ports and the wider community and establish safeguards to reduce the risk to the crew, passengers, and port personnel onboard.*
- Improve the security skills and awareness of all employees.*

Company shall provide the necessary support to the CSO, Master and SSO, in order to fulfil their duties and responsibilities.

In a conflict between commercial interests and the aims of the Security Policy, the Master must prioritize this Policy and the objectives mentioned above. To achieve this, he must:

- Actively promote security awareness among all employees.*
- Consider the decisions of the international shipping community.*
- Schedule in advance, as far as possible, the voyage, the cargo handling, and all ship operations to foresee possible dangers and take the necessary precautions.*
- Provide security procedures and practices for ship's & Company's operations and to protect the security of the ship, ports, the wider community and Company's & Vessel's Information Systems.*
- Establish safeguards to reduce the risk to visitors, crew and shore personnel on-board the Company's ships.*
- Regular documented reviews and internal audits.*
- Prepare contingency measures for emergencies relating to possible security incidents.*
- Identify, assess and treat information security risks tailored to Company.*
- Establish appropriate guidance and mitigation measures for security principles and threats.*
- Protect the Company's & Vessel's assets (incl. information) from all threats, whether internal or external, deliberate or accidental, to ensure operations continuity, minimize damage and maximize return on investments and relevant industry opportunities*
- Manage cyber risks as part of the overall approach to safety management and protection of the environment*

All employees must comply with the requirements of the SSP and be familiar with their security duties and the measures necessary to protect the ship from any unlawful act.

In the event of an attack on the ship or hijack attempt, preserving the lives of the ship's personnel has priority over any other considerations.
